The university has the responsibility to protect researchers, the university community and its assets, and the environment, by assuring the safe use and storage of potentially hazardous biological material in research or teaching at the University. The university also has the responsibility to assure compliance with all federal, state, and internal requirements to prevent the theft, diversion, or misuse of potentially hazardous biological agents.

### **Reason for the Policy**

This policy is intended to ensure that covered individuals report and fully disclose financial and business interests that relate to their university responsibilities so that potential conflicts of interest can be reviewed and, where conflicts of interest are found to exist, eliminated, reduced, or effectively managed. The policy also ensures compliance with applicable federal rules governing conflicts of interest in grantfunded projects.

### **Reason for the Policy**

Faculty, staff, and students create numerous copyrightable works in the course of their employment by, affiliation with, or attendance at LUC. It is essential to have clear rules for conditions under which ownership of the copyright vests in the author, in the university, or is jointly owned. It is also necessary to lay out procedures for dealing with copyrighted works produced with grant support. And finally the policy needs to address the issue of the distribution of any income that may be earned by the university on behalf of, or jointly with, authors who are subject to the policy.

#### **History**

Files in ORS indicate that the existing "Copyright Policy" was last updated in 2007. In 2013 a "creative works" subcommittee of the University Copyright Committee worked on developing a replacement for the 2007 policy. However, this replacement never received the approval of General Counsel's office, primarily because it would conflict with language in the existing Faculty Handbook.

### **Reason for the Policy**

Sponsors and auditors must be able to verify that funds committed to cost sharing or matching have been provided. In addition, it is essential that the use of cost sharing does not overburden departmental and university resources. Therefore, this policy has been developed to help faculty properly budget and report cost sharing and matching funds, and to indicate when administrative approvals are required at the grant proposal stage.

#### **History**

Updated June 2014 to provide for Provost's office approval for proposed cost share in excess of \$25,000 (direct costs) per grant. Updated March 2015 to add that matching amounts over \$25,000 (direct costs) also need Provost's office approval.

Faculty, staff, and students may make discoveries and inventions, or improvements to existing technology or materials, in the course of their employment by, affiliation with, or attendance at LUC. It is essential to have clear rules for conditions under which ownership of those forms of intellectual property vests in the inventor or in the university. It is also necessary to lay out procedures for dealing with inventions conceived or reduced to practice with grant support. And finally the policy needs to address the issue of the distribution of any income that may be earned by the university on behalf of inventors who are subject to the policy.
