### **Biographical Sketch**

Arthur L. Berman was born on May 4, 1935, in Chicago where he attended the Stone Grammar School, Clinton Grammar School, and Senn High School. He earned his bachelor's degree at the University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana, in 1955 where he graduated with honors. That same year, Berman began his study of law at Northwestern University where he graduated in 1958 with honors. During his last year at Northwestern, Berman served as Chairman of the Student Board of Governors and as editor of the Northwestern University Law Review.

Berman's first foray into public politics began with local politics, where he earned the position of 50<sup>th</sup> Ward President of the Young Democrats in 1956. In addition, he participated as a member in the 48<sup>th</sup> and 49<sup>th</sup> Ward Democratic Organizations, from 1968 to 1999. Spurred by early political success, Berman entered the race for Representative in the Illinois House of Representatives in 1966, a post he won and held until 1976. Shortly after, in 1977, Berman ran for and won 9<sup>th</sup> District post of Illinois Senator. Berman held the job until 1999, officially retiring in 2000 as the longest serving Democrat in the Illinois General Assembly.

In addition to his long career in Illinois politics, Berman maintained his status as an active attorney, beginning with the law firm White, White & Berman, a chartered group from 1958-1974. He also served as Special Attorney for the Bureau of Liquidations for the Illinois Department of Revenue from 1962 to 1967, and Special Assistant Attorney General for the State of Illinois from 1967-1968. Over the next 25 years of his political career, Berman also worked at five different law firms, and it was to law that Berman retired to when he left politics, serving as Attorney; Director of

Labor Mediation Services for the Chicago Public School system. He began that post in 2000 and as of July 2003 holds it still.

Arthur L. Berman's membership in organizations and committee work during his political and legal career is extensive. An abridged list includes the Democratic Party of Evanston, Chicago Urban League, Illinois CPA Society, Metropolitan Planning Council's Network 21, Education Advisory Board, American Judiciary Society, Community and Residential Services Authority, Advisory Council CityPAC, Education Committee on the Assembly of the Legislature, Education and Job Training Committee of the State Federal Assembly, Professional Advisory Board, Learning Disabilities Association of Illinois, Board of Directors, Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith Chicago Region, and the Rogers Park Community Council. From this shortened list, still apparent is Berman's longtime interest in Illinois Education, where he championed as State Senator Illinois schools and tackled such issues as funding, parks, playgrounds, teachers, unions, crime, illiteracy, and special education. His interest and advocacy in these areas culminated in the passage of several school reforms into law and earned Berman the nickname of "The Education Senator."

## **Scope and Content**

The Arthur L. Berman papers consists of 17 linear feet spanning the years 1977-2003, predominately from 1990-2002, and includes publicity papers, campaign materials, correspondence, press releases, and news clippings, photographs, awards, biographical information, and memorabilia.

### **Series 1: Biographical Information: Personal & Professional, 1984-2000, n.d., Boxes 1-2**

Contains information related to Berman's personal and professional development. Included are campaign materials. **Subseries 1A: Senator Berman's Forum** relates to his public access program and **Subseries 1B: Senator Berman Reports** relate to his yearly newsletter sent to his constituents.

### **Series 2: Political Involvement & Interests, 1984-2000, n.d., Boxes 3-6**

Contains information related to Berman's general social and/or political interests, committee and legislation work. The topics range from crime and detoxification centers to Chicago parks and anti-defamation programs. **Subseries 2A: Education** includes the bulk of materials related to Berman's long time interest and activism in Chicago education reform.

### **Series 3: Social Politics, 1978-2000, n.d., Boxes 7-8**

**Subseries 3A: Awards/Invitation/Thank You** includes awards as well as invitations and thank you's from his friends and constituents. **Subseries 3B: Retirement** contains materials related to his retirement from office and being honored by Mayor Daley with his own day. Also present is correspondence related to retirement including cards and notes.

### **Series 4: Illinois Politics, 1982-1999, n.d., Boxes 8-11**

Contains materials related to general Illinois political activity including campaign literature of people other than Berman, news clippings, several papers related to Illinois politician Glen Poshard, and several newsletters of Illinois political organizations. **Subseries 4A News Clippings:** includes news clippings related to Illinois political issues, some national political issues and figures.

**Series 5: Audio & Visual, 1990-2000, n.d., Boxes 12-13**

Includes VHS and BETA videocassettes, mainly Berman's Forum television program but also include some documentaries or news specials on political and social topics. Other formats include one three-inch floppy disk that contains Berman's newsletter material. Copies have been made from this disk and are filed into "Berman Reports." Also included are two cassette tapes both concerning education. The first is a reproduction of a Berman speech celebrating education reform in 2000, the second, a copy of the Illinois Education Funding Reform Series compiled by WNIU, Northern Public Radio in 1993.

**Series 6: Ephemeral Materials, 1986-2000, n.d., Boxes 14-18**

Contains several oversized and three dimensional objects, awards, and certificates. **Subseries 6A: Campaign Material** contains large campaign posters, t-shirts, sweatshirts, and buttons. **Subseries 6B: Framed & 3-D Materials** contains framed art, three dimensional awards, and framed awards. **Subseries 6C: Miscellaneous** contains Berman's tennis trophies, a large novelty gavel, and street signs.

**Series 7: Photographs, 1998-2001, n.d., Boxes 19-21**

Includes photographs from Berman's political career, including some photographs of Berman with President Bill Clinton, Mayor Richard Daley, Illinois politician Glen Poshard, and tennis professional Chris Evertt. Most of the photographs are from public appearances, award celebrations, dinners, or committee meetings. Some exceptions include family photographs and publicity (professional) photographs taken of Berman for press use.

**Series 8: Plaques, 1977-2001, n.d., Boxes 22-35**

Contains award plaques spanning Berman's political career.

**Series 9: Secondary Literature, 1986-2000, Box 36**

Includes 22 publications of political and social nature, some on Illinois politics, as well as education in Illinois.
