### **Biographical Sketch**

Father Lester J. Evett was born in 1907 in Chicago, Illinois. He entered the Jesuits immediately after his graduation from St. Ignatius High School in Chicago. He did his regency at St. Xavier High School in Cincinnati, where he taught Greek, Latin, and religion. He taught at Loyola Academy from 1940 until 1943 when he entered the army. As an army Chaplin, Major Evett served in the United States, France and Germany. When he came back in 1946, he became assistant principal of St. Ignatius High School in Chicago. In 1947, he began teaching theology at Loyola University and was chairman of the Theology department from 1949 to 1959. Following this he taught at the Loyola University Dental School. Fr. Evett passed away on June 1, 1997, at Clarkson, Michigan.

## Scope and Content

The Lester J. Evett, S.J., papers consist of .5 linear foot spanning the years 1907-1990 (bulk 1943-1990) and include correspondence, curriculum vitae, certificates, citations, programs, family histories, homilies, reports, class photographs, and lists. Subjects include World War II, retreats, alumni, and Loyola University Chicago.
