Biographical Sketch

Imogene King was a pioneer in nursing theory development. Her Conceptual Framework for Nursing and subsequent Theory of Goal Attainment have been influential to the practice of several generations of nurses. Dr. King, born on January 30, 1923 in West Point Iowa, received her diploma in nursing from the St. John Hospital School of Nursing in 1945. She continued on with her education taking both her Bachelor of Science in Nursing and her Master of Science in Nursing at St. Louis University in 1948 and 1957 respectively. She obtained her Ed.D from Teacher's College, Columbia University in 1961. From there she became a professor at Loyola University in Chicago from 1961 to 1966 returning again to develop the Masters in Nursing program from 1972 to 1980. It was during this time that King was actively involved in developing her theories that have been so influential to the profession of nursing. From 1966 to 1968, Dr. King served as the Assistant Chief, Research Grants Branch, Division of Nursing in Washington, D.C. under Dr. Jessie Scott. In 1968, Dr. King assumed the role of the Director of the Nursing School at Ohio State University until 1972, at which time she returned to Loyola University Chicago leaving there in 1980 to complete her academic career at the University of Southern Florida in 1990.

In addition to her academic career, Dr. King spoke at local, regional, national and international conferences on her theory and various topics, as well as continuing to share her wisdom with undergraduate and graduate students by helping them understand and use her theories. Dr. King was an active member in the Florida Nurses Association, the American Nurses Association, and Sigma Theta Tau. Dr. King also had a keen interest in the history of nursing, history of nursing education and in nursing informatics. She developed courses, manuscripts and spoke widely on these topics. Near the time of her

death in 2007, Dr. King had plans to publish a memoir entitled “Eyewitness to Nursing History 1942-2000”; however it was never written when Dr. King passed away in St. Petersburg, Florida on December 24, 2007.

Scope and Content

The Imogene King Papers addendum 1 consist of 12.75 linear feet spanning the years of 1954-2007 and includes published and unpublished manuscripts; speeches; lecture notes; awards; papers; correspondence; photographs, slides, transparencies and videos. The collection has been arranged chronologically within series.

Series 1: Biographical, 1960-2007, undated. Box 1

This series contains King’s student papers; transcripts; calendars; evaluations; certificates; cards; curriculum vitae; and newsletters.

Series 2: Correspondence, 1929-2007, undated. Boxes 1-3

This series contains correspondence with various people. Subjects include K.I.N.G. International; University of South Florida; Florida Nurse’s Association; and manuscripts. .

Series 3: Speeches and Conferences, 1962-2007, undated. Boxes 3-4

Series 3 contains speeches, outlines, and notes. Subjects include “The Changing Role of the Professional Nurse Providing Care for You”; “Functions of Theory”; “Theory of Goal Attainment”; “The Information Age and Waves of Change”; and the “Impact of Nursing Knowledge on Healthcare Informatics”.

Series 4: Humor in Nursing, 1978-2003, undated. Box 4

This series includes articles, cartoons, newspaper clippings, quotations, and speeches on humor for both the workplace and therapeutic use in nursing

Series 5: Teaching and Course Materials, 1958-2005, undated. Box 5

This series includes notes, transparencies, and syllabi. Subjects include the theoretical basis of nursing practice, information and communication theory, nursing science, curriculum and evaluation in nursing, research methods, and concept development.

Series 6: Theory (Development of King’s Conceptual Framework and theory), 1956-2005, undated. Boxes 5-7

This series contains lecture and meeting notes, manuscripts, research notes, articles, and transparencies. Subjects include General Systems Theory; Theory of Goal Attainment; the concepts of health, pain and role; King’s “World View”; and nursing as a science, theory.

Series 7: History of Nursing and Nursing Education, 1960-2002, undated. Box 8

This series includes notes, manuscripts, bulletins, and articles. Subjects include the Report of Nursing and the Goldmark Report; “History of Nursing”; “History of Men

in Nursing”; the American Association for History of Nursing; and the Center for Nursing Historical Inquiry.

Series 8: King’s Manuscripts: Published and Unpublished, 1966-2006, undated, Boxes 9-10

This series contains published and unpublished manuscripts by King. In addition the series includes articles about King’s theory from other authors.

Series 9: Nursing Informatics, 1964-1997, undated, Boxes 10-11

This series includes articles, manuals, speeches, and proceedings. Subjects include the University of Maryland Summer Institute in Nursing Informatics, nursing informatics and nomenclature.

Series 10: American Nurses Association and Sigma Theta Tau, 1960-2005, Boxes 11-12

This series contains newsletters, proceedings, bylaws, notes, awards, and correspondence. Subjects include the American Nurses Association (ANA) and Sigma Theta Tau.

Series 11: Reference Articles/Materials and King’s Random Handwritten Notes, 1986-2006, undated, Boxes 12-13

Series eleven contains articles and notes on subjects ranging from nursing shortage facts, telehealth, stroke, nursing technology and neuroscience, and the relationship between faith and reason.
