Administrative History

The Loyola University Chicago Department of Natural Sciences was an interdisciplinary department designed to increase students' understanding of their relationship with the earth and universe, while promoting scientific thought and ethical judgment. It offered programs and courses connecting science, philosophy, and history tailored to each student's specific interests.

In 2011, the Department of Natural Sciences and its programs were phased out and replaced by the Department of Environmental Sciences. The last chairman of the Department of Natural Sciences was Dr. Christopher Peterson, who later became the first chairman of the Department of Environmental Sciences in 2012.

Scope and Content

The records of Loyola University Chicago College of Arts and Sciences' Department of Natural Sciences consists of 0.75 linear feet spanning the years 1955 to 1989. These records include committee and national correspondence, administrative requests, minutes, and documents on academic and extracurricular programs. Arrangement is alphabetical.
