## Goldwater Scholarship

• For sophomores and juniors in sciences and engineering planning a career in research

- NOT for students planning to practice medicine, nursing, clinical psychology, public health
- Up to \$7500 per year



# Campus process

- Campus deadline is January 11, 2022
  - online questionnaire
  - research essay
  - three letters of recommendation
  - Transcripts
- Final deadline is Friday January 29, 2022,
   5:00 pm CST
- LUC can nominate up to **four** students

### Resources

- Fellowship Office
  - We run the nomination process, including collecting your letters of recommendation and transcripts
  - We can assist with short essay responses
- At least one technical reader for the research essay
  - Your faculty advisor or PI of research lab



## Challenges

- Online application (which can be glitchy)
  - Please tell the FO about problems as they arise
  - Not a challenge, but important:12-point Arial ONLY
- Pre-application system
- Upload system for campus reps



### Nominations

• Pre-application: we will only decline those applicants who do not meet the basic eligibility requirements (3.00 GPA, correct major and career goal, US citizen etc.)

• After campus deadline (January 11), we review all applications for our four nominations

• You will be notified sometime during week of January 18 of your nomination status



#### Recommendation letters

- Campus reps collect LoRs directly from faculty
- Therefore, the FO will be in touch with you to get names of potential letters-writers before the campus deadline
- When you speak to recommenders, make sure they use the <u>campus deadline</u> (Jan 11) as their deadline for letters, NOT the final deadline (Jan 29)

### 2019 stats

An enormous change from previous years:

- 1223 nominations
- 496 grants (41% of applications)
- No Honorable Mentions because of partnership with DoD National Defense Education Programs
