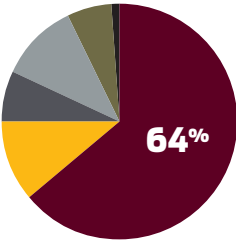

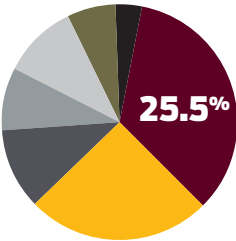
EMPLOYED BY JOB TYPE*
