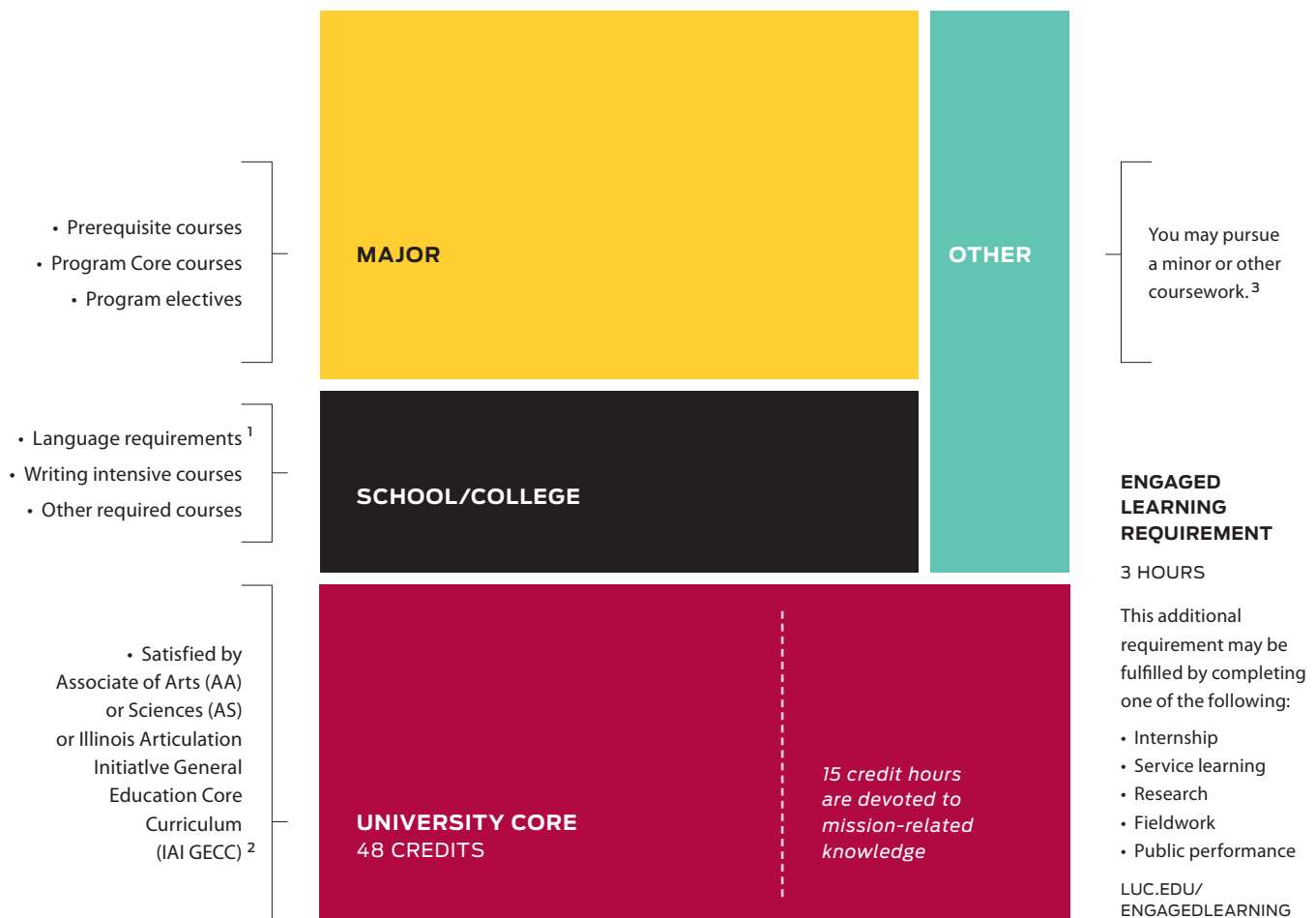

NOTES

¹ Majors in arts, sciences, communications, environmental studies, and international business require the completion of non-English language courses up to the 120 level or transfer credit.

² A maximum of 64 credit hours can be transferred from a community college. Other associate's degrees, including in Applied Sciences (AAS) and Associate of General Studies (AGS), may fulfill some core requirements

³ Some students need elective classes to reach the 120 credit hours required to earn a bachelor's degree. An optional minor concentration and/or other coursework (i.e. pre-health requirements) can increase requirements by a semester or more.

FULFILLING THE UNIVERSITY'S CORE REQUIREMENT

Transfer students without associate's degrees can satisfy the University Core in two ways. Most will be guided by Loyola's Core curriculum, although students entering with a high number of credit hours may follow Illinois' general education standard and take additional mission-related courses.
